- This competition has given us the chance to express ourselves and explore and represent the interest towards everyone taking part in the setting.

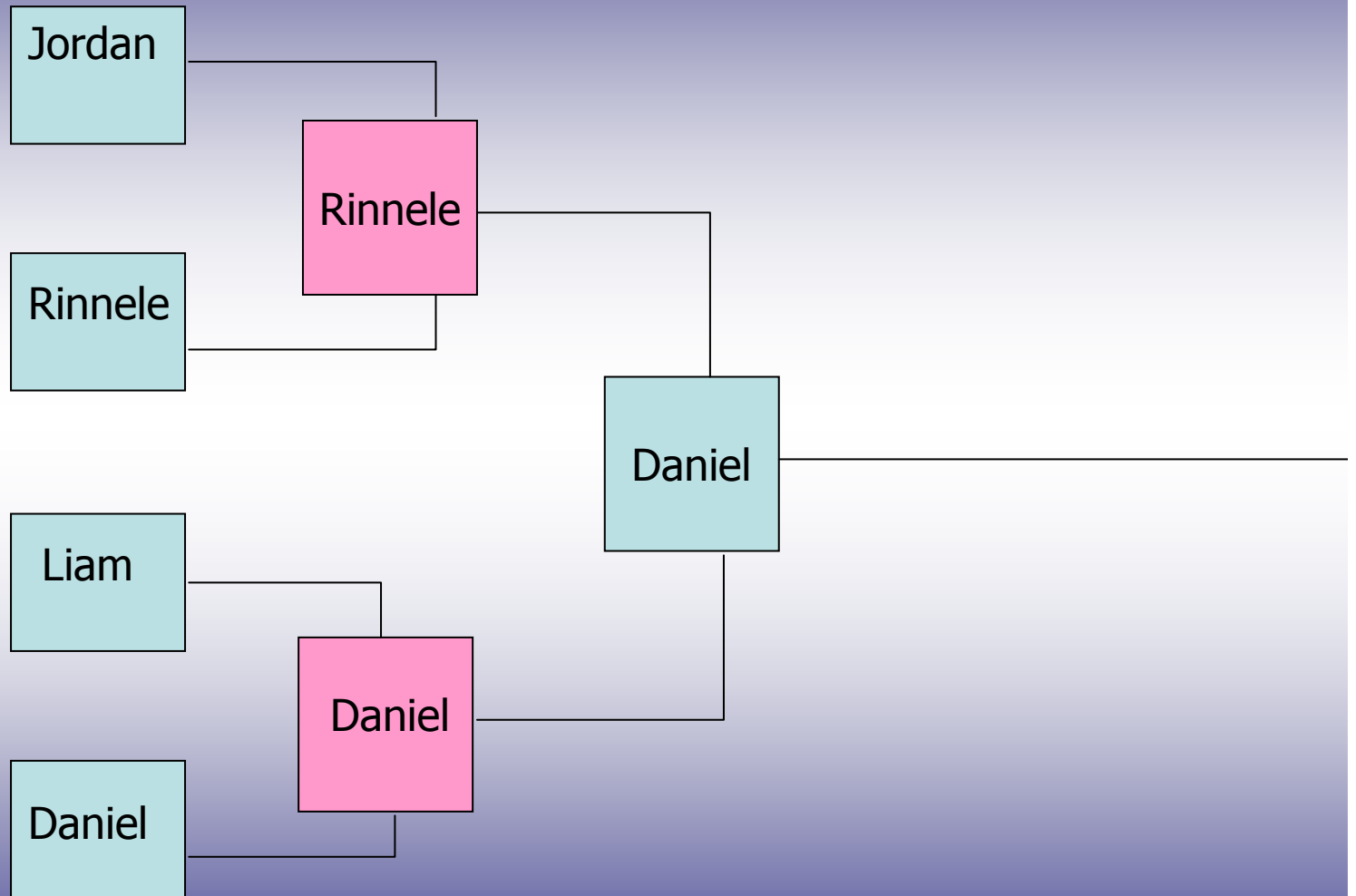

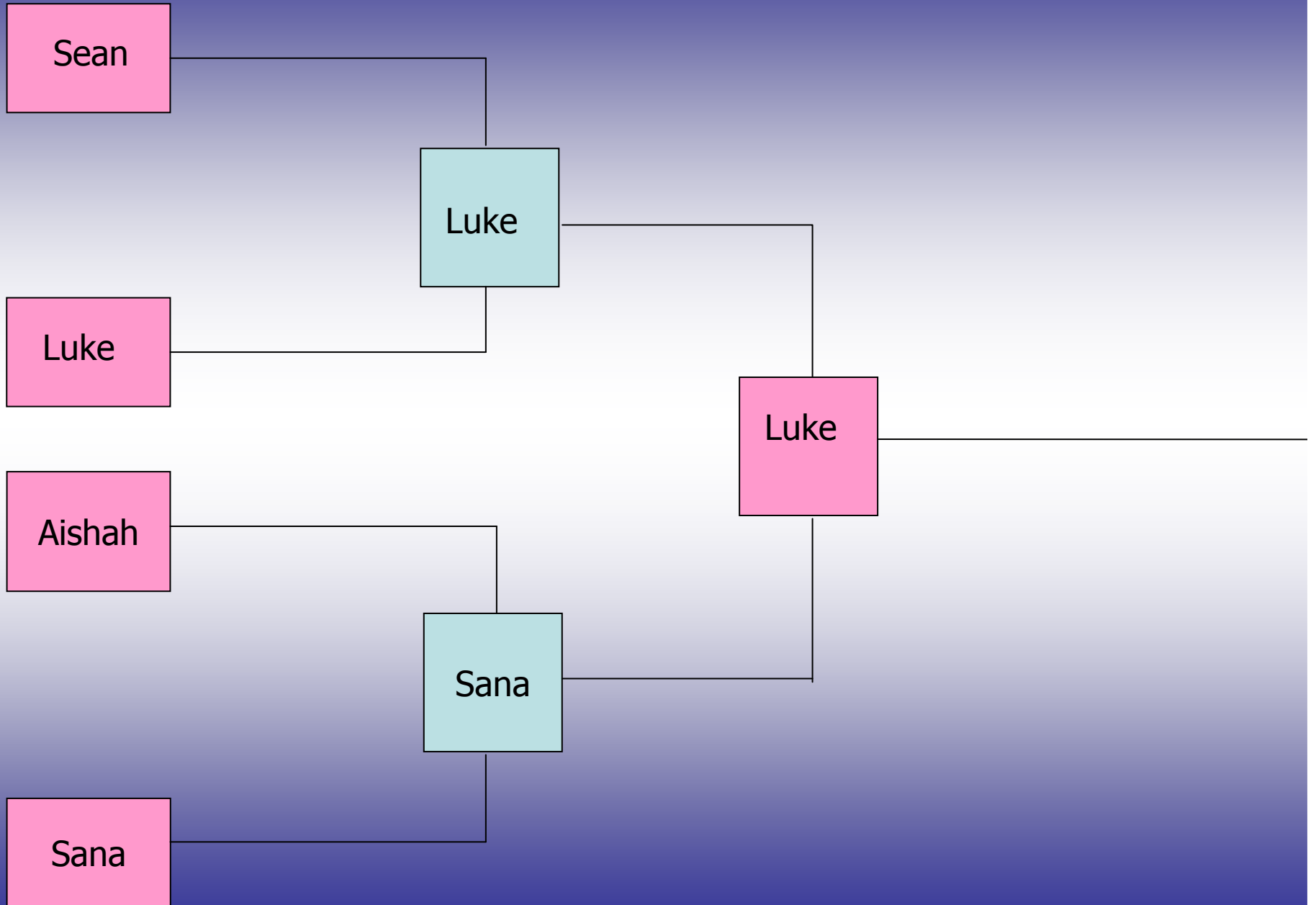
- We are addressing the possible ways in which we can display the people taking part in the badminton tournament in order to create a schedule whereby everyone who wants to take part can take part.
